



# Enduro Carnival Points System Explained

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## Time Trial 1 & 2 – Points System

Each rider gets three attempts to record their fastest time. Riders will leave in a designated order at 15 second intervals.

1 Place = 10 points

2 Place = 9 points

3 Place = 8 points

4 Place = 7 points

5 Place = 6 points

6 Place = 5 points

7 Place = 4 points

8 Place = 3 points

9 Place = 2 points

10 Place = 1 points

## Rider Etiquette Rules

We'll attempt to set the fastest riders off first so they don't get held up by other riders. In the event a rider comes up behind you please allow them to pass when there is space. It is etiquette for the overtaking rider to beep their horn, yell or rev their engine to get your attention. Please don't be offended if this happens to you, they are only trying to get your attention.

## Hill Climb – Points System

You get three attempts to make it up the hill, you can put your foot or feet down but if you roll backwards then that counts as a fail.

First Attempt = 3 points

Second Attempt = 2 points

Third Attempt = 1 point

## Balance Test – Points System

You will ride into a designated area marked on the ground, once you stop the time will start.

3 seconds = 1 point

6 seconds = 2 points

10 seconds = 3 points

## Slow Race – Points System

Riders will line up on a start line and will be required to complete the distance in the slowest time. If you put your foot down you are out of the race, if you travel backwards or sideways you will be out of the race. The last 5 competitors to past the finish line will earn points.

Last Rider = 5 points

Second Last = 4 points

Third Last = 3 points

Fourth Last = 2 points

Fifth Last = 1 point

## Wheelie Competition – Points System

Each rider will attempt to wheelie their motorbike as long as they can. They will receive three attempts.

20 metres = 1 point

30 metres = 2 points

40 metres = 3 points

## Enduro X Circuit – Points System

Riders will have three attempts to record their fastest time around this short, tight circuit riddled with logs.

Beat the times allotted to earn your points

1.15 = 3 points

1.25 = 2 points

1.40 = 1 point

Please note these times are an example only the actual times will be provided on the day.

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## Final Round Club Championship

The final round of the Club Championship will be run over the first two time trials. The person with the most points combined from each race will be the winner. There are two categories:

Open (16 years to 44 years)

Masters (45+ years)

## Please Note:

Every rider who entered the Enduro Carnival has also entered the final round of the club championship. If this is the only round you have entered then you can win the round but not the overall Club Championship which includes results from the previous 6 courses.

## Enduro Carnival

The person who finishes with the most points from all 7 events will be the winner. There are two categories:

Open (16 years to 44 years)

Masters (45+ years)

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
